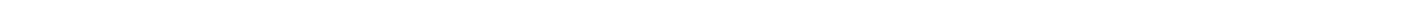

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 15, 2021 CAPTAIN'S MEETING: OCTOBER 26, 2021



INSURANCE: All motor driven units must provide proof of insurance. The Ruskin Memorial VFW Post 6287 is not liable for any accident or injury incurred as a result of participation in the parade or in any of the events prior to or following the parade.

Cost: Any organization, business or individual interested in promoting patriotism and celebrating our veterans are invited to participate at NO cost.

SAFETY / SECURITY: Please read the parade rules below and share the information with all members of your organization to ensure a safe and fun parade for everyone.

1. Our parade permit is for a **ROLLING PARADE ONLY**. All parade participants must keep moving and not stop for any kind of demonstration of their skills, entry or group.
2. Avoid any large gaps between other groups of participants and strive to maintain an evenly spaced, continuously moving parade.
3. Throwing beads and candy is permitted; however, they must be thrown only to the east side (right hand side) and over the barricades or onto the sidewalk area to prevent anyone from going in the street to pick up any items. No beads or candy are to be thrown into the median strip or to the west side (left hand side) of the parade route into the south/north bound traffic lanes.
4. Out-riders or security escorts are encouraged for motorized entries and all youth groups.
5. Each entry will receive an entry number which will determine their placement in the staging and parade route as well as be used for recognition by the Master of Ceremony and the panel of judges. This number must be predominately displayed on the right hand side near the front of any vehicle or person. Duplicate numbers can be provided for multiple vehicles.
6. Be lined up in your assigned position well in advance of the start time as the parade kicks off promptly at 11:00am
7. When turning off Highway 41 into the parking lot you must keep moving all the way into your designated staging area so the rest of the parade is not standing idle or blocking the procession behind it. **At the Captain's Meeting on October 26, 2021 you will receive a map with your assigned entry number and staging area information. It is MANDATORY for a representative for your group attends this meeting to ensure complete understanding or assignment information.**

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE WELCOME back to VFW Post 6287 following the parade for the awards ceremony, food, music and on-going festivities.
